



MoCo is pleased to further our mission to support our local, dynamic community by implementing the 'Round it Up for Change Program'!

Here's how it works:

Staff members will offer MoCo shoppers the option to round up their purchases to the nearest dollar, every time they check out. At the end of the collection period, those funds are donated to the chosen nonprofit.

Criteria to apply:

Organization must be a 501(c)(3) nonprofit registered in Lamoille County.

Organization's work must align with MoCo's mission.

(Please note that MoCo does not donate to individuals, partisan organizations or organizations that advance a particular religious view.)

Application Process

The Round It Up For Change calendar year runs from Dec 1 - Nov 30. Each collection period runs for two months: December 1 - January 31; Feb 1 - March 31; April 1 - May 31; June 1 - July 31; August 1 - September 30; October 1 - November 30.

All of the six nonprofit organizations for the year will be chosen in October from the qualifying applicants, and all applicants will be notified of the outcome.

The six recipient nonprofit organizations for 2020 will be chosen by member vote at MoCo's annual meeting on October 16. There will also be ballots and information about the organizations in the store beginning on October 2nd.

MoCo's responsibility is to raise awareness of the sponsored organization:

Information on nonprofit recipient will be provided on the in-store bulletin board, on signage at the point of sale, on our website and in the "MoCo Beet" eNewsletter.
