- Ballet Wolcott**
Ballet Wolcott believes in quality dance education and offers syllabus in dance that is focused on children's developmental needs and believes in integrating creativity and dance into the community. Funds from Round It Up will be used to build a scholarship fund so that the dance experience is more accessible to children, teens, and adults.
- Friends of Lanpher Memorial Library**
Friends of LML will use Round It Up funds to support their many free community programs - from providing new reading materials, to running a free speaker series, to installing and maintaining "Little Free Libraries" throughout Lamoille County.
- Green Mountain Support Services**
With its mission to "empower neighbors with disabilities to be at home in the community," GMSS's person-centered focus provides services to individuals with physical and developmental disabilities. Funds will be used for education and community outreach programs.
- Healthy Lamoille Valley/Lamoille Family Center**
Healthy Lamoille Valley is a coalition of community organizations and individuals working collaboratively to reduce youth substance misuse and encourage youth to make substance free healthy choices. Funding from Round It Up will be used to support youth programs, including the Lamoille Area Youth Council.
- Justice For Dogs**
Justice For Dogs is an all volunteer non-profit, dedicated to recuing abandoned, abused or surrendered local dogs and cats and to finding successful "forever" homes for them. JFD provides many additional support services to help folks be able to keep their pets or to provide for the animal's well being.
- Lamoille Community House**
LCH is a shelter that provides clean beds and hot meals to people in our community experiencing homelessness. With kindness and dignity, LCH offers guests hope, security and connection to community. Their intent in 2021 is to move from a seasonal shelter to a year-round model and increase staff capacity to coordinate housing reentry and move towards ending homelessness in Lamoille County.
- Laraway Youth and Family Services**
LYFS is an independent non-profit school that provides educational, therapeutic foster care, therapy and behavioral intervention support to at-risk children living in Vermont. Funds will support their Crisis Fund that helps mitigate unexpected crises for the children and families they serve.
- Morrisville Alliance for Commerce and Culture (MACC)**
MACC is the non-profit booster of all things Morrisville, bringing projects and events to support the economic well-being and cultural creativity of Morrisville. From art installations to locally installed planters of growing vegetables for all to pick, MACC works to make Morrisville a more welcoming, beautiful, walkable and user-friendly town.

- Mountain River School**
MRS is an independent school serving students from Pre-K through 8th grade. By emphasizing real-world learning experiences and a hands-on approach, students are given the opportunity to connect to the culture, economy and ecology of local places. Funds will directly support students from diverse socioeconomic backgrounds- currently 50% of the school's students.
- North Country Animal League**
NCAL is an animal welfare organization, located in Morrisville, dedicated to building compassionate relationships between animals and people offering a broad range of services, such as saving the lives of pets, humane education, preventing animal cruelty, spay/neuter programs, sheltering and finding loving adoptive homes for pets.
- Racial Equity Alliance of Lamoille (REAL). Fiscal Sponsor: Helen Day Arts Center**
REAL is a community coalition with a vision that embodies inclusion, equity and justice as values central to its identity. REAL is committed to building a safe community, where all people experience dignity and respect, and all are welcome with kindness and belonging.
